Protective overlaminate film can be used in combination with Avery Dennison® SignFlex™ White printed with Latex, UV, solvent or Eco-solvent inks. The main application area is flexible substrates like tarpaulins.

Note: The durability of a printed image always depends on the toner/ink, film, type of overlaminate, processing and exposure conditions. The film's surface can show alterations in matting due to contact pressure or other external influences. Please note that increased roller temperatures in combination with higher winding tension could lead to unwanted elongation of the film. Winding tension should therefore be carefully monitored and kept at an appropriate level.
